1. Must allow Spirit to controll thought process.

And now, behold, bound by the Spirit. Acts 20:22

We take captive every thought, make it obedient to Christ. 2 Corinthians 10:5

Don't be drunk with wine. Instead, let your mind be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts. Ephesians 5:18
